

THE CLASSROOM DISCIPLINE CHAIN

In every classroom:

Staff: Will provide a positive and safe environment for pupils to learn **Pupils:** Will work with staff and other pupils in a respectful way by following the Toynbee Expectations

Staff should follow the staged approach below if pupils do not fulfil their responsibilities as outlined in the 'Toynbee Expectations' document

Stage 1:	Verbally address the behaviour with the Pupil
Stage 2:	Give the Pupil a clear verbal 'Warning'
Stage 3:	Send the Pupil to work in a Buddy Room <i>Issue a Sanction & arrange a Restorative Meeting</i>
Stage 4:	Call 8888, pupil removed from the lesson Issue a Sanction & arrange a Restorative Meeting HOD/GM will be informed
Stage 5:	In the case of Persistent Disruption or Defiance in future lessons, (eg 8888 callout)

HOD/GM to arrange a further Sanction & Restorative Meeting and agree a Behaviour Plan.

8888 should be called immediately if a Pupil:

Uses verbally abusive or discriminatory language Acts in an unsafe, aggressive or intimidatory way **The incident will be referred to GM, PD/LSL or SLT**
