

Toynbee School Uniform 2023

Girls' uniform:

- Plain white shirt. (short sleeve in the summer if preferred)
- [School Tie](#) – clip-on. (available from the school or Skoolkit)
- [Plain Black Girls Blazer with embroidered badge](#) (available from Skoolkit) or Plain Black Blazer with the school badge to be purchased separately (available from Toynbee Reception or Skoolkit) and sewn onto the left breast pocket.
- **Years 7,8,9 are required to wear** the [Grey Tartan Box Pleat Skirt](#) (available from Skoolkit) or black trousers (not leggings, jeans or jeggings – not tight material). No other style of skirt is acceptable.
- **Years 10 and 11 are required to wear** a black pleated knee length skirt or black trousers (not leggings, jeans or jeggings – not tight material). No other style of skirt is acceptable.
- Black Cardigan/v neck jumper. (plain acrylic/cotton/wool – no design or logo)
- Plain black shoes (leather/vinyl) – no canvas shoes, trainers, boots or pumps (photos supplied on the school website) Please note: shoes with silver tags, 'air bubbles', different coloured branding/laces or shoes that are noticeably used for sports are also not permitted
- Black or grey woollen tights
- Black, grey or white ankle socks
- Suitable coat.

Boys' uniform:

- Plain white shirt. (short sleeve in summer if preferred)
- [School Tie](#) – clip-on. (available from the school or Skoolkit)
- [Plain Black Boys Blazer with embroidered badge](#) (available from Skoolkit) or Plain Black Blazer with the school badge to be purchased separately (available from Toynbee Reception or Skoolkit) and sewn onto the left breast pocket.
- Black school trousers. (not leggings, jeans or jeggings – not tight material)
- Black senior day shorts (available from skoolkit)
- Black Jumper – v neck. (plain acrylic/cotton/wool – no design or logo)
- Plain black shoes (leather/vinyl) – no canvas shoes, trainers, boots or pumps (photos supplied on the school website) Please note: shoes with silver tags, 'air bubbles', different coloured branding/laces or shoes that are noticeably used for sports are also not permitted
- Black, grey or white ankle socks.
- Suitable coat.

Shirts must be tucked in at all times and school blazers to be worn throughout the year.

Standards of appearance:

- Make-up (including false eyelashes) is discouraged, excessive make-up will be challenged. Jewellery, false nails, coloured nail varnish are not permitted in school.
- Girls and boys with pierced ears should, for reasons of safety, wear stud earrings and only one in each ear. Small clear retainers are allowed as a nose piercing. No other visible body or facial piercings are allowed, this includes spikes and expanders. This is not an exclusive list.
- Extreme hairstyles must be avoided:
 - No extreme haircuts
 - No coloured hair, eg. natural colour only
 - No tramlines, razor cuts, beading or non-natural hair or coloured braiding
- Trainers are not to be worn as normal footwear.
- Hoodies, tracksuit tops, sweatshirts or garments with branding or slogans are not permitted.

This is not an exclusive list. Final judgement will always rest with the Senior Leadership Team and Guidance Managers.

Girls' PE Uniform:

- [Plain Black PE Polo Shirt](#) available from Skoolkit or plain black T-shirt.
- [Reversible Rugby Shirt](#) with red band from the school's supplier, or a plain black sweatshirt. (no hoods)
- Black shorts.
- Black or white trainers. (no plimsolls)
- Long red socks or short plain white sports socks. (depending on the activity)
- Football boots (metal studs are not allowed on the synthetic pitch) and shin guards.

Boys' PE Uniform

- [Plain Black PE Polo Shirt](#) available from Skoolkit or plain black T-shirt.
- [Reversible Rugby Shirt](#) with red band from the school's supplier, or a plain black sweatshirt. (no hoods)
- Black shorts.
- Black or white trainers. (no plimsolls)
- Long red socks or short plain white sports socks. (depending on the activity)
- Football boots (metal studs are not allowed on the synthetic pitch) and shin guards.
- Boxer shorts must not be worn during PE lessons; tighter fitting underpants should be worn.

A towel for use after taking a shower, and changes of underwear and socks, are essential. All PE kit should be taken home after use for washing. Pupils should be reminded to bring it to school on the appropriate days and should not wear their day clothes for PE. A gum-shield is recommended for hockey (boys and girls) and rugby (boys) but is not compulsory.

Please ensure that you place your order well in advance of the school term starting in September.

Ties: You will be able to buy the school tie from the school or Skoolkit. Stock will be available in school during term time. All pupils wear a black and grey striped tie.

Badges: If the Blazer does not have the Toynbee embroidered badge, these can be purchased from the school reception. They should be hand sewn onto the blazer, positioned at the left breast pocket.

Final judgement regarding acceptability will always rest with the Senior Leadership Team and Guidance Managers
