Dear Parents.

On behalf of Hampshire County Council, we have been asked to make you aware of the 'connect4communities' programme, which is providing financial support to households with food, energy and water bills this winter.

As part of the connect4communties programme, schools, early years settings and colleges have been given funding to provide Food Vouchers to families with children and those who may be struggling financially - perhaps due to loss of income as a result of the COVID-19 pandemic - during the Christmas and February school holidays.

If you have been provided with an <u>eYougher</u>, you can use it at a supermarket or in one of Hampshire's community pantries where your money could go up to three times further. You can purchase a range of fresh, <u>frozen</u> and general foods at a lower rate each week at a community pantry.

Access to the pantry is normally through membership. However, families using their eyoucher in a community pantry will not have to pay the usual £5 weekly membership fee as part of the exchange for purchasing at least £15 worth of food and supplies.

The Food Voucher Scheme is one of several projects we have planned as part of the connect4communities programme. Other projects include:

- Support from Citizens Advice to help those struggling with energy and water bills
- Christmas school holiday food and activity clubs (which includes a daily hot meal and fun, educational activities/playschemes)
- Food and fuel vouchers available from Family Support Services and Community Pantries
- Slow cookers for families without basic cooking facilities
- Setting up a 'connect4communities' <u>online directory</u> for residents to search by postcode to find financial and other support and subsidised food
- Supporting the establishment of Community Pantries
